



Fleas are not overly difficult to control with a well-rounded pest management plan. The following checklist outlines the customer's role in ridding their home of fleas. We are confident that if you follow these steps, your home will be flea-free and we guarantee that for two months from the treatment date if your role is fulfilled as outlined below. Please note that severe infestations may take more than one treatment for total control.

### **Before Treatment**

- Get your pets treated for fleas by the veterinarian.
- Vacuum all carpets, rugs, curtains, couches, chairs, and other upholstery thoroughly. It is important to vacuum all sides of furniture and rugs. Dispose of the vacuum bag outside in a sealed plastic bag.
- Wash all pet bedding, sheets, mats and anything else they may lay on (including your bed sheets) in hot water and dry on high heat.
- Remove all items except furniture from carpets and rugs.
- Unplug and cover fish tanks.
- Remove all animals from the household.
- Clean and put away all dishes and food items.
- Be prepared to vacate the home for at least two hours following the treatment.

### **Following Treatment**

- The home may be entered two hours after being treated.
- Ventilate all rooms by opening windows.
- Thoroughly wash all table and counter-tops.
- Thoroughly vacuum all carpet, rugs, curtains, couches, chairs, and other upholstery daily for at least two weeks. Dispose of the vacuum bags outside in a sealed plastic bag.
- Fix any problematic areas mentioned by the technician that could lead to reinfestation.
