



We are proud to offer a variety of weed control tactics. Please refer to the headings below to help prepare for the treatment we are about to perform. We are confident that if you follow these steps, your landscape will have a drastic reduction of weeds; we guarantee it.

Lawn/Landscape Preemergent – prevents weeds from popping up

- Clean up leaves, debris, and other organic material covering the lawn/landscape. These chemicals work best with a direct route to the soil.
- Keep people and pets away from the treatment area until the spray has dried.
- If there is no rain in the forecast for the next 48 hours, water your lawn/landscape with about 1” of water. It is important that this be done for the chemicals to work. However, wait at least a couple of days before you water if this treatment is bundled with a postemergent..
- Do not disturb the soil of the treatment areas.
- With this treatment, you can expect a drastic reduction in weed emergence, but rarely will you see zero weeds. We recommend a lawn weed program for a 100% weed free lawn.

Lawn/Landscape Postemergent – kills weeds that are already up and growing

- Clean up leaves, debris, and other organic material covering the lawn/landscape. These chemicals will not work if they cannot contact the weeds.
- Avoid mowing for two days before and for at least two days after treatment. Mowing too soon will negate the effects of the chemicals.
- Do not water one day before and for one day after treatment. Water will dilute and negate the effects of the chemicals.
- Place any pets in kennels or inside the home until after the spray has dried.
- Do not walk across treated areas until after the spray has dried.
- With this treatment, you can expect very good control of all emerged weeds.
